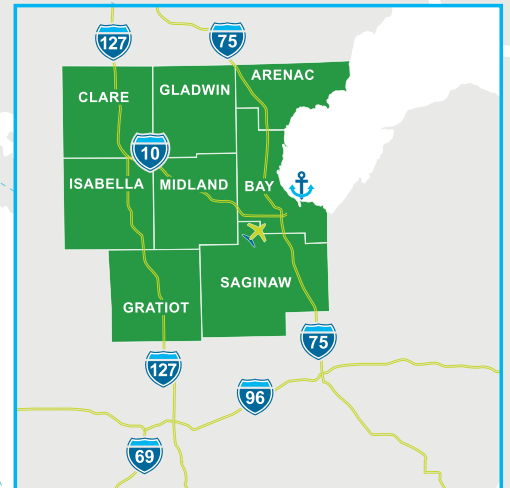

**POPULATION**

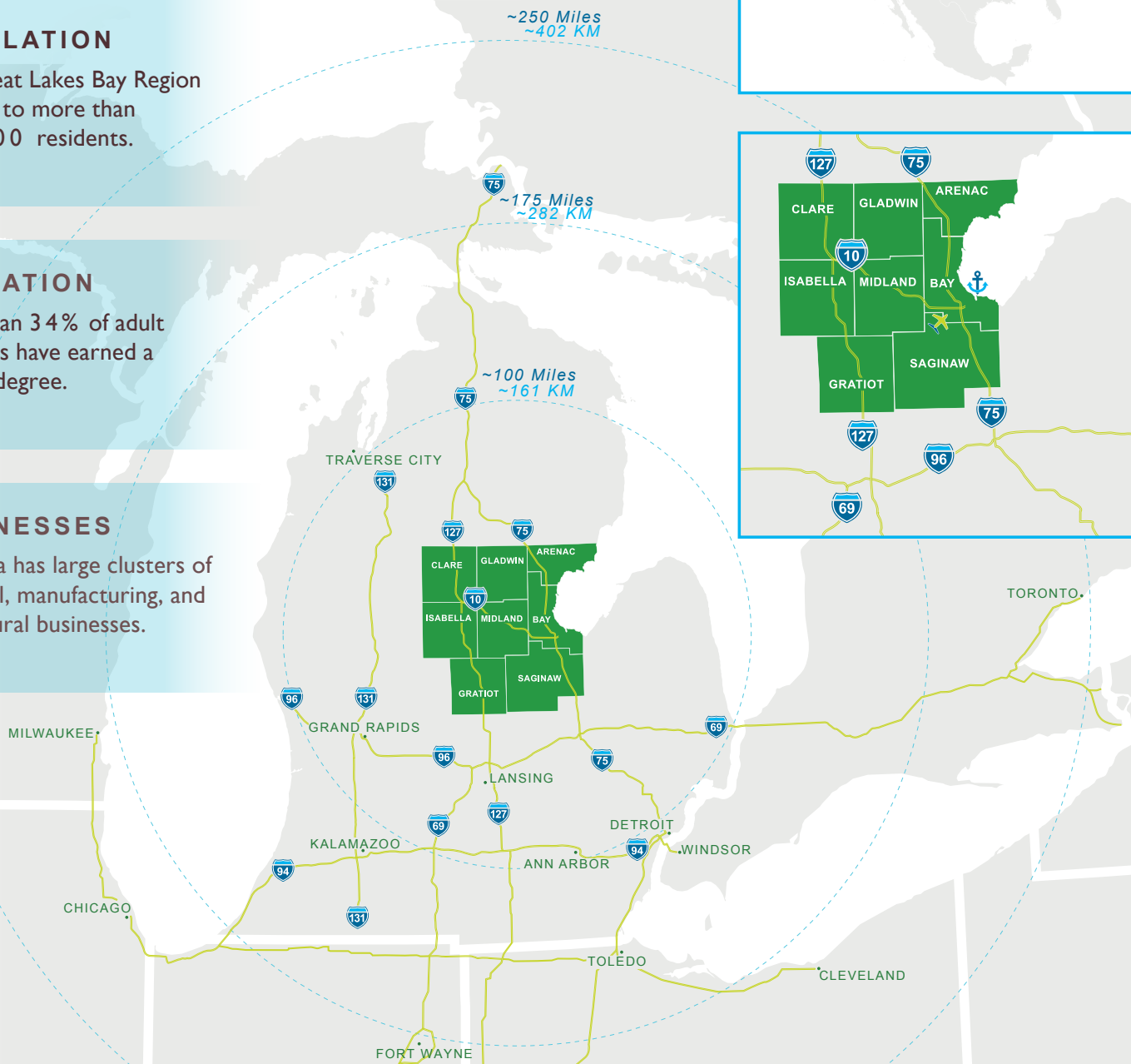
The Great Lakes Bay Region is home to more than 550,000 residents.
