Established in 1992, SFI is a private, nonprofit alliance of local businesses, the Saginaw County Chamber of Commerce, the County and City of Saginaw, 15 local municipalities, labor organizations and local foundations.



Mission

The mission of Saginaw Future is to increase economic opportunity in Saginaw County by facilitating and supporting business retention, expansion, attraction, and new business development. SFI collaborates with business, education, government and community partners to position Saginaw County as a great place to live, work and locate a business.



Vision

To be recognized as the premier organization providing proactive and focused economic development assistance, striving for diversified growth, increased tax base and job creation and retention for all of Saginaw County.



Services & Expertise

Saginaw Future assists companies with financial and incentive packaging, state programs, government contracts, identifying and developing sites and provides access to shovel ready FREE land. SFI also serves as an advocate for business investment projects, connects with resources to address workforce needs and serves as a community liaison, through our service contracts with local and state government partners.



Budget

SFI is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation with an annual operating budget of \$1.1 million. SFI contracts with the County and City of Saginaw and 15 local units of government for economic development services, and receives nearly half of its funding from 188 private business contributors, foundations and individuals. SFI also receives grants from the MEDC and U.S. DOD for procurement initiatives.

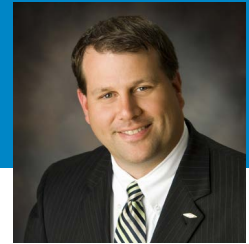

Nexteer is a global leader in advanced steering and driveline systems. In-house development and full integration of hardware, software and electronics gives the company an unmatched competitive advantage as a full service supplier. Nexteer's vision is to be a leader in intuitive motion control – leveraging strengths in advanced steering and driveline systems. They have maintained product focus on electronic power steering, a socially responsible technology that offers automakers increased fuel economy and reduced emissions. Nexteer attributes its success to its world class employees, innovative technology and safety, comfort, performance and reliability of its products. In addition, Nexteer is a leader in Michigan's Community Ventures Program, which provides meaningful employment to those needing a second chance. The company has 21 manufacturing plants, five regional engineering centers and ten customer service centers in North and South America, Europe and Asia.

General Motors Saginaw Metal Casting Operations

www.gm.com

is investing \$50 million in driveline components and its facility in the City of Saginaw. The project retains 68 jobs and is part of an overall investment of more than \$356 million in Michigan that also includes Flint and Grand Rapids. The Michigan investment announcements came on the same day as an amended agreement between GM and the Michigan Strategic Fund under the Michigan Economic Growth Authority (MEGA) tax credit program. As part of the amended agreement, which was approved by the Michigan Strategic Fund, GM will invest \$1 billion in Michigan by 2030. The recently announced investment of \$356.35 million represents more than one-third of that amount. Since 2009, GM has made investment commitments in Michigan of more than \$9 billion. During this time period, GM has far exceeded its original investment commitment under the MEGA Agreement. GM's substantial investment in Michigan and the corresponding job growth and retention has contributed to Michigan's economic success since 2009.

Firehouse Subs opened a new franchise at 5208 Bay Rd., just north of Tittabawassee. Brothers - Ken and Sean Hoffman hired 45 people to fill part- and full-time positions. SFI assisted with site location information, facilitated contact with a realtor representing the property and also with Kochville Township and the Kochville DDA. www.firehousesubs.com

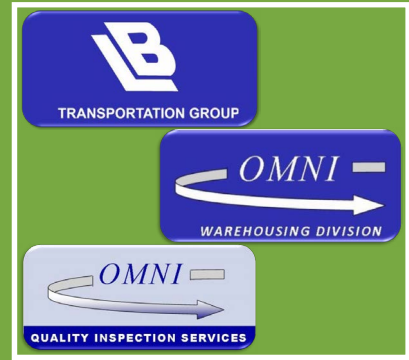

The operation features sales, service and leasing operation for Mack Trucks. Interstate Trucksourc has already hired five employees, including three diesel mechanics and expects to hire seven additional staff.

is a distribution, assembly and kitting company that outgrew its City of Zilwaukee location. In order to continue growth, available space was found at the former Nash Finch building on Dixie Highway in Bridgeport Charter Township. The facility will accommodate current operations and allows for future expansion and adding manufacturing capabilities.

Real property improvements of nearly \$300,000 were needed for manufacturing upgrades and 30 new jobs are expected to be created.



SARGENT DOCKS & TERMINAL INC. invested over \$2 million in upgrading its rail yard. The company is installing a new rail spur, which will allow for whole unit train access. The addition will greatly reduce the cost of shipping for Sargent and its customers. The company provides bulk construction and agricultural materials by ship, rail and truck. The project was made possible by a Michigan Department of Transportation grant that will cover 50% of the cost. Sargent hired two new employees as a result of the investment, with many more hires anticipated in the near future. www.sargentdocks.net

The new 213,500 sf facility will be near I-75 and M-81 and is expected to be completed by early Summer 2016. As a result of the work, EZ Pro Delivery has hired two new employees and retained five jobs.
