EXPANSION MAGAZINE GIVES SWAN VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT A GOLD STAR RATING

The editors of Expansion Management Magazine, a national site selection publication, have given the Swan Valley School District its top education award in the Ratings 2000 issue. The school district received recognition for its high graduation rates and college board scores. Swan Valley obtained 131 out of 150 possible, earning the Saginaw County School District a Gold Star.

The education quotient rating is based on a weighted index that includes college board scores, graduation rates, student teacher ratios, per pupil expenditures and community index. Secondary School Districts with at least 700 students located in cities or towns with a population of at least 15,000 were eligible for rating.
